The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality proposes to issue a new discharge permit to: Vreba-Hoff Dairy for the Vreba-Hoff Dairy facilities located at 7601 Dillon Highway and 8502 South Meridian Road, Hudson, Michigan 49247, Lenawee and Hillsdale Counties.

A Public Hearing with the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality is being held to seek public input on the proposed issuance of the discharge permit for Vreba-Hoff Dairy. This meeting will be held on May 22, 2008, at the Hudson Middle School Gymnasium, 771 North Maple Grove Avenue, Hudson, Michigan 49247.

Note that this is the same date and place as the hearing for the Waldron Dairy permit. The Waldron Dairy hearing will begin at 6:30 p.m. and continue as long as needed. The hearing for the Vreba Hoff Dairy permit will begin after the Waldron Dairy hearing, but will start no earlier than 7:30 p.m. Persons who wish to make only one comment for both permits should preface their comments with a statement that the comment applies to both permits.

All interested parties are invited to present comments on the proposed NPDES permit. The submittal of written comments, in addition to verbal comments, is encouraged. Persons unable to attend the public hearing may submit written comments to Mike Bitondo as specified below.

Comments or objections to the draft permit received by May 29, 2008, will be considered in the final decision to issue the permit.
